Maturity

 Very late

Massive is a very late-maturing oat variety.

Growth Habit

 Semi-erect

Key Features


- Very quick to first grazing, very late maturing
- Good seedling vigour
- Excellent growth during Autumn, Winter and Spring
- High tolerance to grazing

Plant Characteristics

- Large seed size
- Enormous leaf size
- Low growing point

Where can I grow it?

- Can be sown in many different regions but is better suited to higher rainfall inland areas.
- Suited to both dryland and irrigation conditions
- Suited to most soil types

 *Massive is a modern forage-oat cultivar. Its enormous leaf is derived from a joint Australian/North American breeding program with the aim of providing good early feed but having the capacity to survive tough conditions.*
